CONSTRUCTION OF SKILL BLOCK AND SKILL TRAINING COURSES

The College has been designated as a Skill Training Centre by the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) (ID TP152073) in recognition of its successful implementation of NEP 2020, which emphasizes skill development.

In connection to this college has constructed an 8 room Skill Block which was handed over to the college by the end of the year. The Skill Block now houses advanced laboratories for skill-based and multidisciplinary courses. These facilities are equipped with modern tools and technologies to support hands-on training in diverse areas like Robotics, IoT, Web Development, Apiculture, and Mushroom Cultivation, in alignment with NEP 2020.

The College has begun offering skill-based courses aligned with NSDC standards and tailored to complement the NEP 2020 curriculum. Considering the local economy, resources, and entrepreneurial opportunities, the college has expanded its offering of skill-based courses, including Web Designing, Food Preservation, Vermicomposting, Mushroom Cultivation, Beekeeping, Organic Farming, Cut-Flower Technology, Disaster Management, and Psychological First Aid. These courses provide students with practical skills, preparing them for employment or entrepreneurship. Students receive hands-on training and field exposure in major, minor, multidisciplinary, and skill subjects, keeping them attuned to contemporary technologies and industry practices.
